The Annual Percentage Rate will be equal to the Prime Rate plus a margin of: _____% for Purchases, Cash Advances, and Balance Transfers, rounded to the nearest 100th of a percent. The interest rate can change on the first day of each billing cycle following a change in the Prime Rate. Any increase will lengthen the time it takes to pay off your loan.
