Fraudsters are increasingly using fake QR codes to steal sensitive information or redirect users to deceptive websites. These codes appear on flyers, parking meters, emails, or even fake ads – making them easy to overlook.

Before you scan:

- · Verify the source
- Avoid scanning codes from unknown or suspicious locations
- Use your phone's built-in scanner or a trusted app
- Double-check the URL before entering any personal information
