What You Should Know About Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your checking account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have **standard overdraft practices** for your account. This notice explains our **standard overdraft practices**.
- 2. We also have optional overdraft plans, such as a link to a savings account or a line of credit, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more about our optional overdraft plans, ask us for details.

What are the **standard overdraft practices** for my account? With our standard overdraft protection, also called Courtesy Pay, we <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We will <u>not</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for ATM transactions at all, and <u>will not</u> pay overdrafts on everyday debit card transactions on existing accounts unless you ask us to (see below).

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means that we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if Golden 1 pays my overdraft?

Account Number:

Under our standard overdraft practices, you will be charged a fee of **\$29.50** each time we pay an overdraft. There is a limit of six (6) overdraft fees per day; otherwise, there is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account, but the maximum amount of overdraft coverage provided is \$500 including the amount of the transactions and assessed fees. All terms are subject to change in accordance with our Disclosure of Account Information.
